



Heart Screening Event – April 2025

The **Cardiac Risk in the Young** screening team once again held a two day screening at "The Space" at South Hunsley School with the cost of the event covered by past donations to Jamie's Memorial Fund at CRY.

As always, we are most grateful to everyone at South Hunsley School for their assistance in enabling us to host these events and in making the venue available to us, as well as helping to set up.

Jamie's legacy enabled **186** young people to have an ECG heart tracing and the CRY Cardiologist (Research Fellow) in attendance reviewed all the ECG traces and scans and she spoke with each person to discuss their results. On this occasion the CRY team were unable to carry out echocardiograms if required, due to unforeseen circumstances. However, **3** people were referred for a follow up with their GP or further tests with regards to symptoms/family history. Around half a dozen or so were also advised to return for a retest in 12-18 months due to their current young age.

National CRY statistics from over 20 years of screening show that 1:100 people screened will have an irregularity with their heart and 1:300 will have a potentially life-changing condition.
